The Catholic Church's 106th Day of Migrants & Refugees 6 facts to think about

1. There are 70.8 million people around the world who have been forcibly displaced—the highest level of displacement since World War II.
2. Among the forcibly displaced, there are 25.9 million refugees, 41.3 million people displaced in their own country, and 3.5 million asylum-seekers awaiting determination on refugee status.
3. More than half of the world's 25.9 million refugees are under 18.
4. Developing countries house more than 80% of the world's refugees.
5. Around 70 percent of refugee families live below the poverty line.
6. One person is forcibly displaced approximately every two seconds.
